

RULES OF COMPETITION

The organizer of competition is Hämeen Moottoriseura ry. The competition is based on the technical and safety rules of the hobby club of the Finnish Hobby Motorsport Association (Hamu ry). More information on Hamu ry's page <http://www.harrastemoottoriurheilu.fi/saannot.php>

OVERVIEW

The total length of the race is 210 km including 7 special stages, with a total length of about 65 km. If a competitor or a competitor's representative is on a route on the yellow, gray, black or unmarked roads of the Ikaalinen, Hämeenkyrö or Kankaanpää road ahead of the competition, the competitor will be denied the opportunity to participate in the competition and the event will be reported to the Finnish Hobby Motorsport Association.

SCHEDULE

Notice of race and the rules will be published on January 30, 2018, registration starts and route is closed from the competitors and their representatives.

The "cheaper" registration period with the accommodation package will start on January 21, 2018 and end on March 15, 2018 (quota 50)

Registration ends on Sunday 24.4.2018 at 18:00.

The competition list and competition guide will be published on 28 April 2018.

COMPETITION CLASSES

The following types of hobby motorsport classes are run in the competition. The categories of competitions are largely adapted to the categories used in hobby motorsport. In addition, there are categories for German racing cars and for lada and vw cars.

- Class 1 Lada / cc free, with original lada engines
- Class 2 VW aircooled engines
- Class 3 with pacenotes, under 1650cc 2wd
- Class 4 with pacenotes, over 1650cc 2wd
- Class 5 with pacenotes, 4wd model of year / cc free
- Class 6 with pacenotes, Junior age 15-18, under 1650cc 2wd
- Class 7 with pacenotes, Deutschland group H under 2000cc 2wd
- Class 8 with pacenotes, Deutschland group H over 2000cc 2wd
- Class 9 with pacenotes, Deutschland group H 4wd
- Class 10, Junior age 15-18, hobby rally under 2050cc 2wd
- Class 11 Classic, <81, 82-90 over 1350cc
- Class 12 Classic, <81, 82-90 under 1350cc
- Class 13 Senior, 2wd cc free
- Class 14 Women, 2wd cc free
- Class 15 Women, 4wd cc free
- Class 16 V1600
- Class 17 Hobby motorsport, under 1650cc
- Class 18 Hobby motorsport, under 2050cc
- Class 19 Hobby motorsport, over 2050cc and 2wd turbo fuel free
- Class 20 Hobby motorsport, under 1400cc / standard under 1600cc
- Class 21 Beginners 2wd with a maximum of 5 competitions

REGISTERING, SELECTING COMPETITORS AND MAKING OF ENTRY LIST

Registration takes place at www.ajaksi.fi. The system sends a confirmation to your email. The competition will be accepted by 200 registered competitors. The registration order is determined by the registration fee.

Preliminary criteria: Priority is given to the purchase of the accommodation package, then the registration order (registration fee has been paid), the organizer reserves the right to approve 40 competitors, unlike the registration order. Registration ends on April 24, 2018 at 18:00 or until the maximum amount is met. At least 3 outbound members are required in the category. If the number of participants is lower, competitors in the class can be combined into another category.

REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fee without pacenotes classes is 190€ and with pacenotes classes 270€. Please note the separate fast registration offer packages including accommodation and registration fees. (See the last page of the rules). The registration of a competition may be terminated before this deadline, if the maximum number of competitors is reached.

MAKING PACE NOTES CLASSES 3-9

Making of pacenotes is allowed two (2) driving times / special stage. This is allowed 4.5.2018 at 8-20 and 5.5.2018 at 8-11.

Finnish police and organizer route team is controlling special stages during that time period. If competitor breaks speed limits or traffic rules it may lead to closing from the competition.

Classes 3-9 competitors will receive route map and route book by email latest 3.5.2018 16:00. These will be sent to the email address that competitor will provide upon registration.

Classes 3-9 competitors must notify the registration number of the car which is used to make pacenotes. If after the registration to competition the vehicle changes it must be announced to the competition director.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Participation can be canceled on Saturday, 28 April 2018, until 18:00, when 90% of registration fee will be returned. After that registration fee will not be returned. Possibility to change the driver and the car free of charge until 4.5.2018.

SAFETY INSPECTION OF RACE CARS

Racing cars safety inspection will be held 5.5.2018 at 10am at the location indicated on the competitor's guide. This inspection ensures safety equipment and a number of issues related to roadworthiness. The timetable for the inspection is announced in the competitor's guide.
